My current court order or agreement dated _____ states that monthly maintenance payments are due on the _____ day of each month. I, the creditor on this account, wish for the Maintenance Enforcement Program (MEP) to change their records to show a later monthly due date instead, being the _____ day of each month.

Note: You can choose the "last" day of each month or any numbered date from the 1st - 28th. You cannot choose the 29th, 30th or 31st days of the month because February only has 28 days. The date you choose must be later than the due date in your order or agreement.

Important considerations

By signing this form, I, the creditor, understand and agree that:

- This form does not change my court order. However, by signing this form I am telling MEP to use the later due date I chose above as the date payments are due to MEP.
- If full payments of my monthly maintenance are made by the new due date chosen above, MEP will not apply late penalties, collection action or interest.
- Processing this change in my due date is labour-intensive for MEP staff. For this reason, MEP will allow only one change to my monthly due date per account. I understand that I will not be able to change the enforceable due date again for any reason.
- If a new court order is obtained after this completed form is received, MEP will follow the monthly due date in the new court order.
- It may take MEP up to four weeks to process this form upon receipt.
- I am voluntarily choosing to change the enforceable due date, and I understand that I am not required to make this change.
